Wheelchair and Support Equipment Scheme for Road Accident Victims

- The scheme is on short-term loan equipment available for the road accident victims.
- You must be able to pick up the equipment at our office. There is no fee for our services.
- Equipment loan is on equipment availability and it is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Training on loaner equipment is not provided.
- The maximum loan period is 3 months.

To be eligible to borrow equipment, one must:

- Be a citizen of Malaysia aged 16 and above.
- In support of your application, you must submit copies of: Your I/C; Medical Report; Police Report; One of the utilities bills (TNB/Syabas/Astro)

Wheelchair and Support Equipment Scheme for Road Accident Victims

RSMC wants the community to know about the value of caregiving for road accident victims. Through the project, RSMC provides equipment and supplies to those who need them, with no cost. Items available for loan include wheelchairs, walkers, crutches and other assistive devices.

Terms of Equipment Loan

- i) All equipment may be signed out for a maximum of 3 months. Equipment loans may be renewed based on availability. If an extension of the loan is needed, contact RSMC at least a week in advance of the date the equipment is due.
- ii) It is the borrower's responsibility to accept only equipment in proper working condition as well as returning the equipment in the same condition as when received.
- iii) Extended loans of the equipment will be allowed only with special permission from RSMC. Reservations for extended periods will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- iv) Should equipment become faulty for any reason while in the borrower's charge, no attempt should be made to repair it. If faulty, return the equipment immediately to RSMC.
- v) Under no circumstances should borrowed equipment be loaned to any other person. All equipment transfers must be handled through RSMC.
- vi) Equipment must be returned on time. Extenuating circumstances will be considered only if RSMC is notified before the equipment is past due.

Damaged Equipment

The borrower will be responsible for repair cost (not to exceed the replacement cost) of any equipment which is returned in damaged condition if it is determined that the damage was caused by negligence or abuse.

Costs assessed against borrower will be reduced from the security deposit

Lost Equipment

The borrower will be responsible to pay the cost of replacement of any equipment not returned, or equipment returned which is damaged if negligence is evident.
